

## **CURRICULUM VITAE Dr. Enrico Robotti**

Born in Genova, Italy, on October 10, 1959. High School Diploma at the Marist Brothers' High School "M.Champagnat" at the fourth year of the five year course with honors degree of 60/60. Medical Degree in 1983 at Genova's University Medical School with marks of 110/110 cum laude, with diverse internships in the U.K. during the medical school. (Manchester 1979, Oxford 1980, Cambridge 1981, Stoke Mandeville 1982). - Military Service as Officer in the Italian Navy: Head Medical Officer of the Naval College:"Francesco Morosini" in Venice, then Assistant Surgeon in the General Surgery Department of the Naval Hospital of La Spezia, and assigned on different occasions to active service onboard ships - Board certified (Specialist) in General Surgery at the University of Pavia with top degree of 70/70. Clinical Assistant Professor in Plastic Surgery (tutoring fifth year residents) at the University of Torino School of Medicine, from 2000 to present date. Lecturer at the post-residency subspecialty "Master in Aesthetic Surgery" Courses of the Universities of Milano, Padova and Genova (topic: "open rhinoseptoplasty"). Corresponding Member of ASPS. Member of Educational Council of ISAPS. ISAPS "International Visiting Professor" 2014-2016. Member of the Rhode Island Hospital-Brown University Alumni Association . Member of the Board of Directors of the Italian Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Cosmetic Surgery (SICPRE), years 2001-2002, 2004-2005 and 2007-2008. President of the Italian Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Cosmetic Surgery (SICPRE) for 2012-2013. National ESPRAS delegate for SICPRE. Member of the Board of Directors of the "Fondazione Sanvenero Rosselli", Milan, since 2007. Founding member and current Vice-President of the " Rhinoplasty Society of Europe", established in Stuttgart in 2011. Has led diverse volunteer Plastic Surgery missions to underprivileged countries (Bosnia Herzegovina: a total of four months in Zenica in 1995 and 1996, as Expert of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, founding a plastic surgery dept. ) (West Bank, and Gaza: 14 missions to present date). Author or co-author of over 500 papers and talks, on national and international journals and at national and international meeting venues. (including 30 papers on international journals, 5 monographs and 7 book chapters ). Moderator, Chairman, Panelist or Invited Speaker at many meetings concerning the field of reconstructive or aesthetic surgery. Organizer of 18 courses at the Ospedali Riuniti in Bergamo, with international guest surgeons. In the last few years, he has lectured widely internationally in the major meetings on the topic of open, primary and secondary septorhinoplasty, often with live surgery. He has founded and directed the "First Bergamo Open Rhinoplasty Course" in Bergamo on November 28-29, 2008, an international intensive course specifically devoted to open rhinoplasty. . Subsequent expanded editions of the course followed in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016 and 2018, with a wide participation of attendees from many different countries, thus establishing the "Bergamo Open Rhinoplasty Course" as one of the foremost rhinoplasty symposia in the world. The last 2018 edition in fact counted over 600 participants from 64 countries. Since January 2015 Dr Robotti runs the "Bergamo Advanced Minifellowship in Revision Rhinoseptoplasty", a "hands on" course for a limited number of international surgeons with an interest in

this field. Since 2017, he also runs the yearly course “Live Surgery with Enrico Robotti”. He is Reviewer for the “Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery” and “Aesthetic Plastic Surgery” journals regarding the topic of Rhinoseptoplasty. With over 9000 cases to present date, Dr Robotti has been active in general reconstructive plastic surgery, with emphasis on flap reconstruction in the head & neck, breast, lower extremity and trunk as well as skin cancer reconstruction of the facial district. In private practice, he is predominantly focused on rhinoseptoplasty. The latter subspecialty has especially grown in recent years, with exposure to a significant caseload of national and international patients and a special interest in complex secondary and tertiary cases, usually with rib grafting. Dr. Robotti speaks English as a second language. He is married to Silvia with two daughters. As time allows, he enjoys hiking, fishing and sailing.
